ADMISSION PROCESS

a. WRITTEN ENTRANCE EXAM

An entrance exam will be held on the 2nd Sunday of June at the TKIET, Warana Nagar, Dist.Kolhapur campus. The syllabus for exam will be of XIIth standard level and will consist of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English, of XIIth std and General Knowledge (History, Geography, Economics and Civics) of Xth std. Paper will be of 100 marks on MCQ pattern.
